## Students who complete HIST 261 (New Mexico History) from any NMSU system-wide campus or any other New Mexico college/university will be required to take an additional 3 credit 300+ level ECON, GEOG, GOVT or HIST course to meet the state licensure requirement of 12 upper division (300+ level) credits in Social Studies.

**Developmental Math and Developmental English courses are included on transcripts and will be calculated in the grade point average, but do not count towards total degree credit hours.**
