For more than 8 members, add \$4,180 for each additional member.

Priority is given to children who are 4 years old by September 1st. Families with children with special needs are encouraged to apply! To qualify, total household income must meet 2017 Federal Income Guidelines. Enrolled families will receive program services at no cost.
