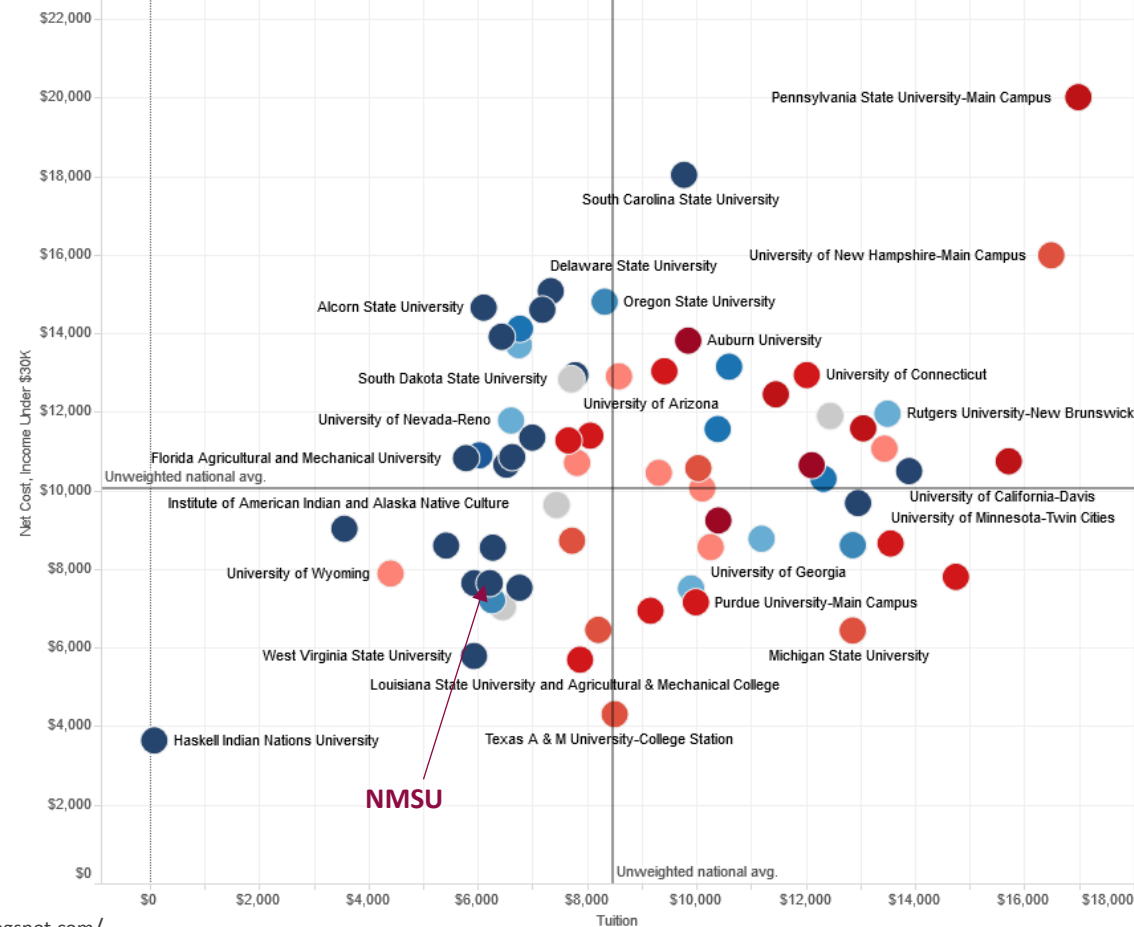


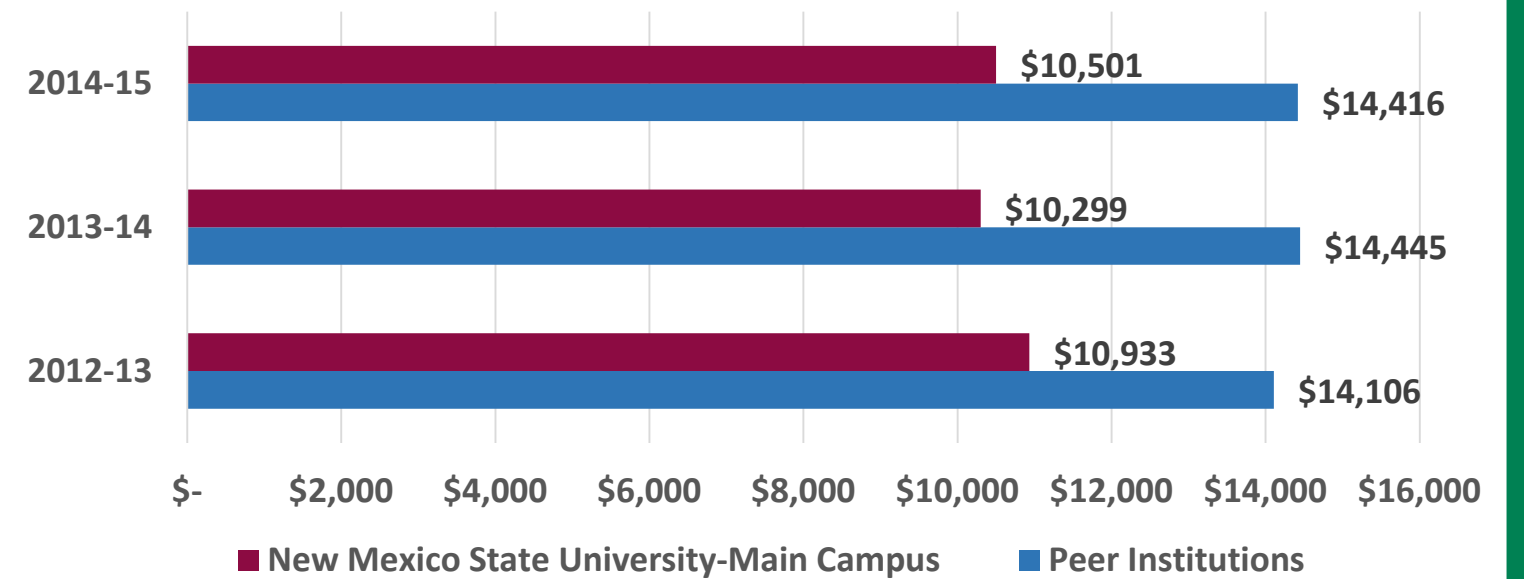

In-state tuition and Net price for income < \$30,000, Land Grant Universities

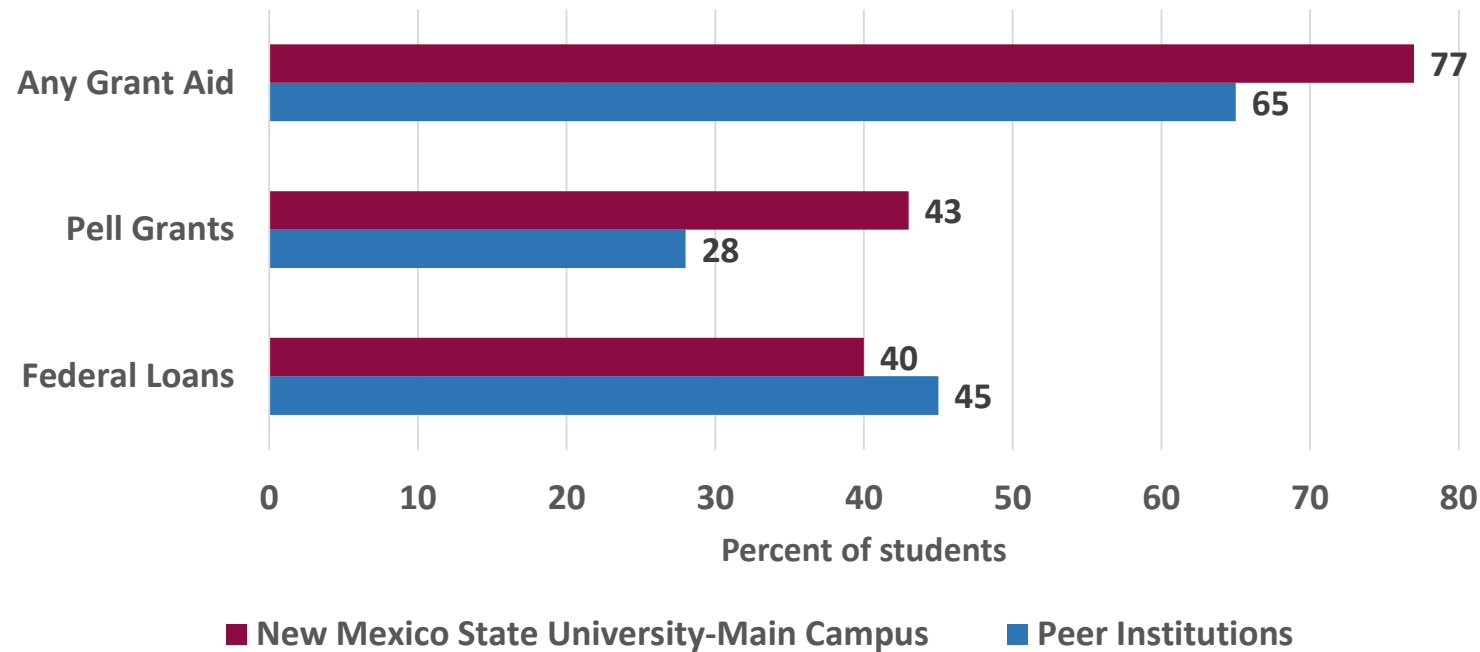

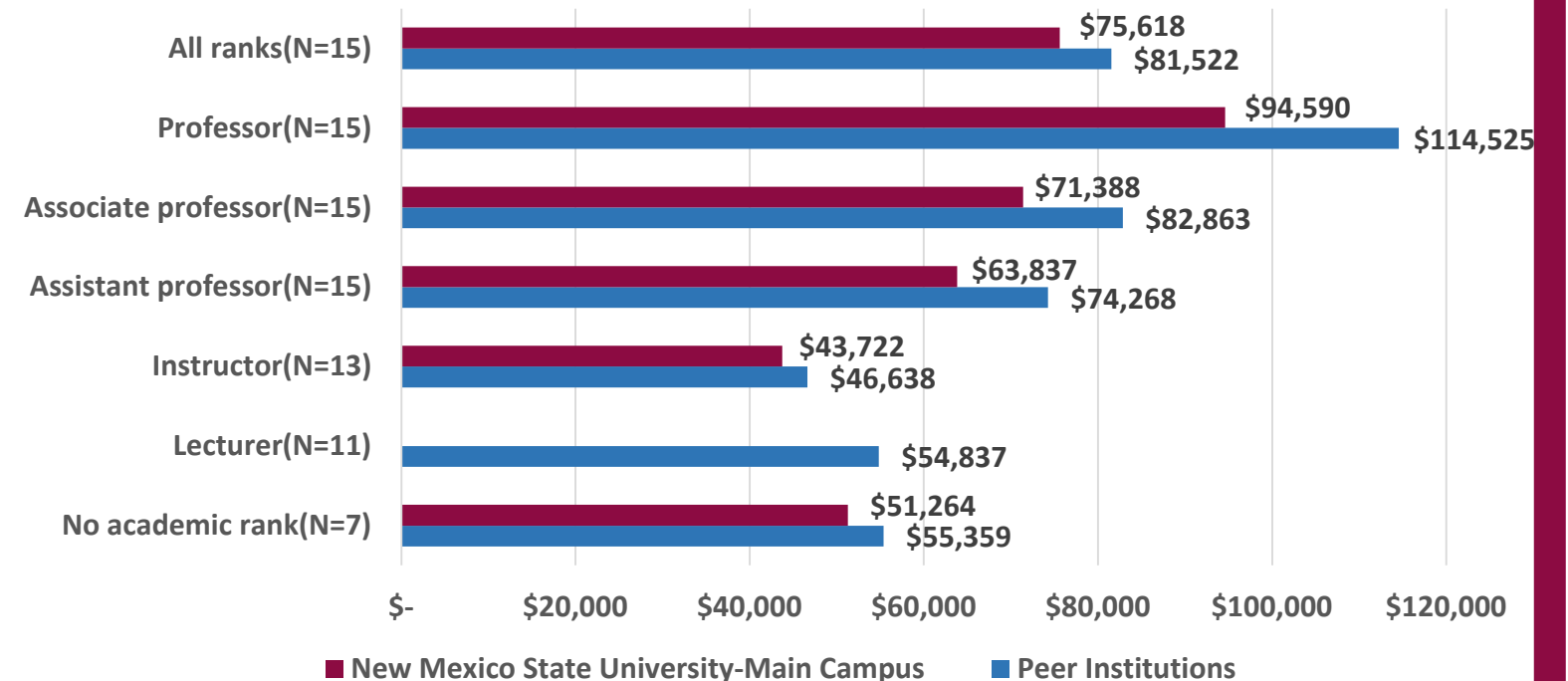
Average net price of attendance for full-time, first-time degree-seeking undergraduate students receiving grant or scholarship aid 2012-13 to 2014-2015



Percent of all undergraduates awarded aid, by type of aid 2014-2015

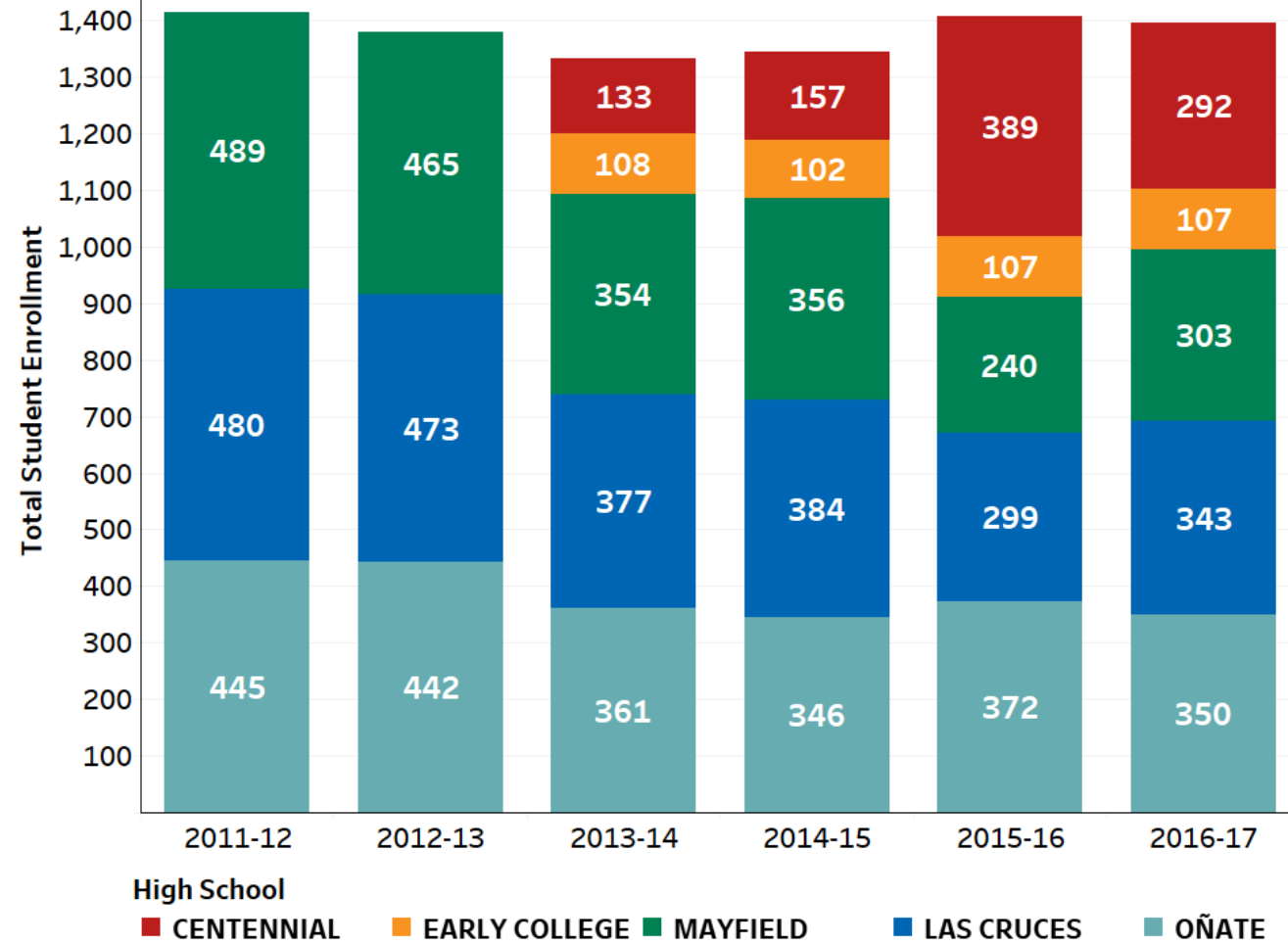


Average salaries of full-time instructional non-medical staff equated to 9-month contracts, by academic rank Academic year 2015-16

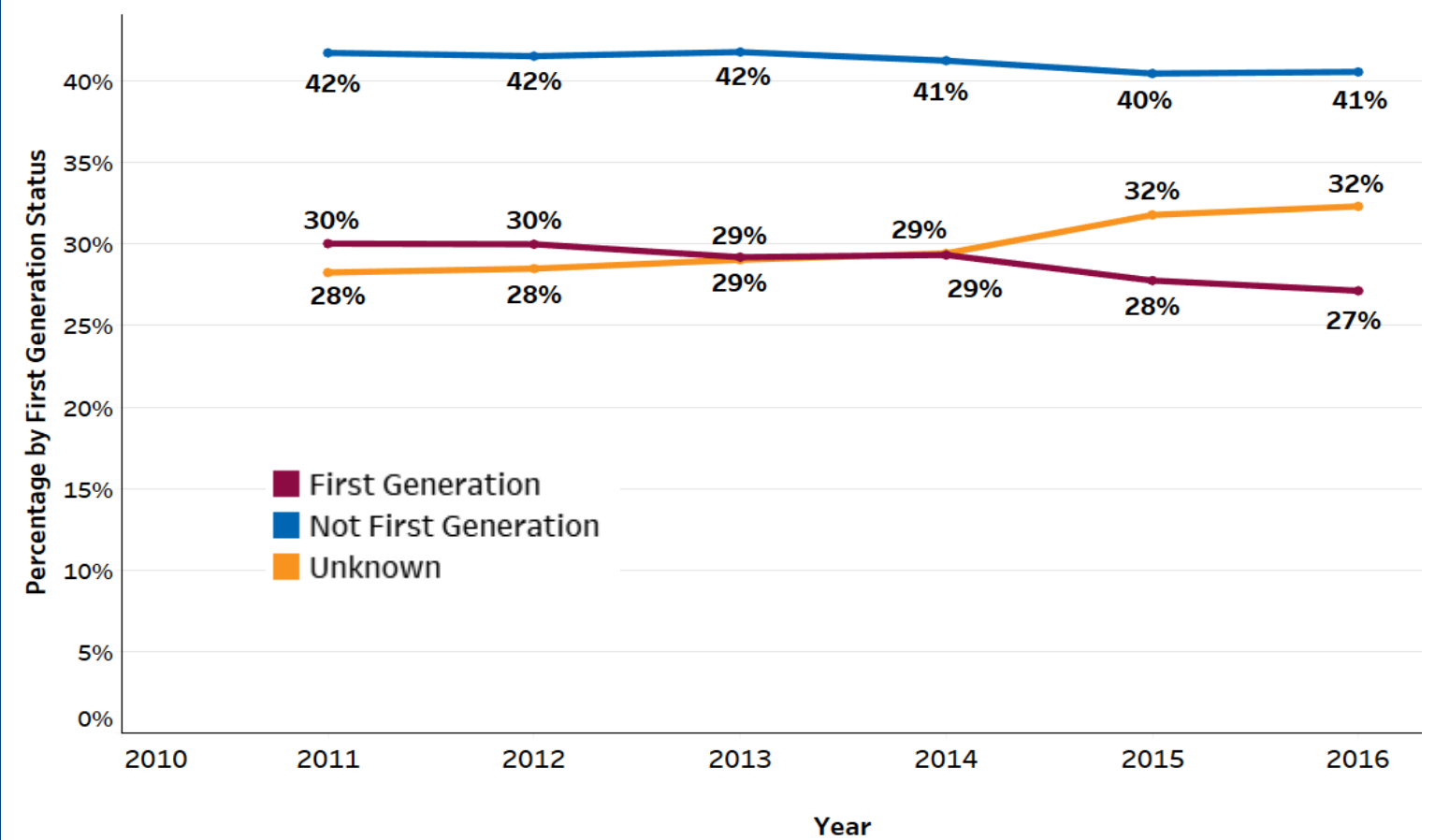


Enrollment Trends and Education in Doña Ana County

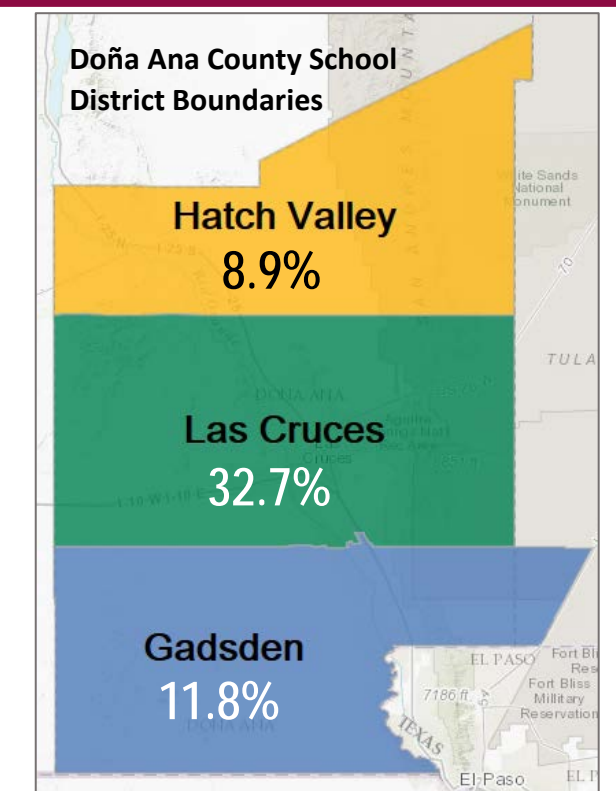
