

NMSU Board of Regents to Meet

The Board of Regents of New Mexico State University will hold a special meeting at 8:00 am on Friday, January 20, 2017 on the main NMSU campus at the University Center and President's Residence, 4501 Geothermal, in Las Cruces, NM. This meeting will be held to discuss internal operations and budget issues within the Board of Regents Office. An agenda will be posted no later than 72 hours in advance of this meeting.

The Board of Regents will meet in executive session (closed) at the University Center and President's Residence on the main NMSU campus at 10:00 am to discuss limited matters concerning personnel, pending or threatened litigation, real estate, and water rights as allowed by the Open Meetings Act. The itemized agenda will be posted 72 hours prior to the closed meeting.

The Board of Regents of New Mexico State University will hold a regular meeting at 1:00 pm on Friday, January 20, 2017 in the Regents Room in the Educational Services Building on the main NMSU campus in Las Cruces, NM.
