

2018 CLI Possible Topic areas, not a definitive list, surprise us!

- **Systems Change**
- **Cultural Humility**, broadening our understanding of what it means to be meaningfully engaged with people from cultures different from our own
- **Substance Abuse**, how to address substance abuse differently (harm reduction, legalization and new/innovative and controversial treatment modalities)
- **Race equity and intersectionality**, including gender and race differences in juvenile justice and child welfare, sexual assault to prison pipeline for girls, how the school to prison pipeline differs for girls of color
- **The Culture of Poverty**
- **Mental/Behavioral Health**, understanding the impact on our families;
- **Preserving relative and sibling connections and maintaining permanency;**
- Helping parents achieve permanency within 12 months even when our systems are not set up to make this happen
- **Domestic Violence**
- **Sexual abuse**
- **ICWA**- more advanced topics and ones that address New Mexico specifically;
- **Education, including the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA)**
- **"Nuts and bolts"** topics such as SSI, SSD, DD waiver and Medicaid workshops;
- **Advanced topics for supervisors and managers**
- **Truly engaging parents** in their plan to reunify with their children--what works, what doesn't?
- **Human Trafficking in New Mexico**
- **Multidisciplinary team approaches (MDT, social worker-legal team models, parent peer mentors)**
- **Integration and collaboration between protective services and juvenile justice**
- **A trauma informed approach for self-care, secondary/vicarious trauma, mindfulness**
- **Juvenile Justice Diversion/Rehabilitation/Reform**
- **Skill based training for attorneys such as Motivational Interviewing, trial skills, mediation advocacy, negotiation**
